4.0 Position summary:

- Facilitate third-party audit activities on behalf of clients. This could include, but not limited to, selection of third-party certification body, contract negotiations, scheduling, interviewing and selecting third-party auditors, represent client’s ISMS system during third-party audit activities and support client’s efforts in resolving third-party audit findings
- Prepare training curriculum, training material (including assessments) and deliver public and on-site training in the ISMS domain. Training topics could include but not limited to: ISO 27001 clause-by-clause interpretation, executive overview and internal auditor training.
